Subject:-Grant of Conditional Permission M.D. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Babarpur, Sikandra, Agra-287007, Uttar Pradesh (Inst.ID-AYU509) for intake capacity with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2022-23 and relevant regulations thereunder-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provisions of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government notified that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. In view of the above the Central Government constituted the Autonomous Boards with effect from 11th June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder. Further, the provisions of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provisions of NCISM Act 2020 shall not be applicable.

1. Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **M.D. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Babarpur, Sikandra, Agra-287007, Uttar Pradesh (Inst.ID-AYU509)** inspection of your College was conducted on **19.07.2022 & 20.07.2022 on hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process **the Conditional permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2022-23 and relevant regulations thereunder.**
2. Further, in view of above, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulation namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016" and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under, and on the basis of Relaxation policy issued by the NCISM dated 16.03.2022. **On examining the same certain deficiencies were observed by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM).**
3. As per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the assessment report was placed in the **21th Board Meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **29.11.2022**. On careful examination of the assessment report it was found that **your college is not fulfilling the notified & approved criteria for issuing of Conditional permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2022-23** and Board decided to provide an opportunity of hearing to your college. Thereafter, an opportunity of hearing was granted to your college on **07.12.2022** to present the case through virtual mode.
4. The observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully re-examined in terms of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, **and once again as per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the recommendation of Hearing Committee was placed in the 24th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on 16.12.2022.** Board verified the same and found that the College is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for **grant of Conditional permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2022-23.**
5. In view of above, it has been decided by the **President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine to issue Conditional Permission to M.D. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Babarpur, Sikandra, Agra-287007, Uttar Pradesh (Inst.ID-AYU509) for intake capacity with 60 seats in UG**

- I. The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
 - II. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 60 seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2022-23 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
 - III. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no.BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/ Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
 7. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
 8. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2022 **and send a compliance report to get permission for the session 2023-24:**
 - i) all the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for undergraduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
 - iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto; and
 9. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission from the academic session 2023-24.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's letter No.R.12011/06/2016-EP (IM-1) dated 21.11.2017 related to admission matter for the year 2017-18 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case for the academic session 2018-19.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 07.02.2018 and re-visited on 025-26.05.2018 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry examining the same, it was observed that- Web based computerized central registration system, Instruments and equipments in the department of Dissection hall, Rasashastra, Dravyaguna, Rog-vigyan Casualty, labour room, Shalya, Shalakya, Herbal Garden, Functional X-ray, ECG & USG, functional OT, Part-time teacher, Specialist doctor or one clinical teacher in Kayachikitsa, Shalya, Prasuti Tantra evam Stri Roga and Kaumarbhritya, required hospital staff, required 02 lecture hall and Functional Teaching pharmacy and Quality Testing Laboratory were not available. Therefore, under provisions of the first proviso to sub-section (5) of Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college on 21.08.2018 and 09.10.2018 to present the case.

3. The observation of hearing Committee based on submission made by the college representatives during hearing and recommendations & visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder, PG Ayurveda regulation, 2016 and as per approved Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs) it is found that College is fulfilling notified and approved criterion for granting conditional permission for UG (BAMS) course with 60 seats.

4. It has been decided by the Central Government for ***grant of conditional permission to Shri Madhudas, Memorial Shikshan Sanstha, 42/154, Bilochpura, Agra,-282002, Uttar Pradesh with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course*** for the academic session 2018-19 under section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 ***subject to the condition that college shall fulfill the deficiencies as mentioned below by 31st December, 2018:***

- (i) Aadhaar based Geo location enabled attendance system for teaching staff, non-teaching staff, hospital staff as per RMS, 2016.
- (ii) Functional Web based computerized central registration system in the Hospital.
- (iii) Functional ECG and USG section in the Hospital.
- (iv) Verification of Functional Operation Theatre on basis of OT stock register, record of surgical cases, attendance of OT staff, OT Anaesthesia/consent records, OT investigations & discharge records etc.
- (v) Verification of the availability of Equipments & Instruments in the Teaching pharmacy and Quality Testing Laboratory on the basis of stock register and purchase bills and pharmacy & Laboratory staff on the basis of on the basis of Appointment & Joining Letter, Salary Record, Bank Salary details and Attendance register.

5. In addition, following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2018 to get conditional permission for the session 2019-20:

- (i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
- (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda) and
- (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*,



Sub.: Application dated 07.04.2016 of the Secretary, Shri Madhudas Memorial Shikshan Sanstha, 42/154, Billochpura, Agra, Uttar Pradesh to start new Ayurveda College in the name of “M.D. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Babarpur, Sikandra Agra, Uttar Pradesh-282007” with 60 seats in BAMS (UG) course, from the academic session 2017-18, under Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970- Letter of Permission -regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to refer your letter dated 07.11.2017 on the above cited subject and to say that the CCIM has suo moto visited the college on 07.07.2017 and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Govt. of India for not granting permission for admission in BAMS (UG) course with 60 seats for the academic session 2017-18 due to the various reasons/shortcomings. The same was examined and it was found that college was not fulfilling the criteria as per MSR for grant of conditional permission. Therefore, after giving due opportunity of Hearing to the college, the college was denied permission by the Central Government to take admissions for 60 UG seats in BAMS course for the session 2017-18 vide this Ministry's orders dated 19.09.2017, as the college could not substantiated their claim against the shortcomings mentioned therein.

2. In view of your representation dated 07.11.2017, the matter has been re-examined and it has been decided by the competent authority of Central Government to grant permission to the Secretary, Shri Madhudas Memorial Shikshan Sanstha, 42/154, Billochpura, Agra, Uttar Pradesh to start new Ayurveda College in the name of “M.D. Ayurvedic College & Hospital, Babarpur, Sikandra Agra, Uttar Pradesh-282007” with admission capacity of 60 seats in BAMS (UG) course, under Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 and regulations made thereunder, from the academic session 2017-18.

3. The college may therefore take admissions for 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2017-18 subject to the condition that the following requirements should be fulfilled by the college positively by the 31st December, 2017 to get conditional permission for the session 2018-19:

- (i) The college shall ensure availability of required no. of teaching faculty as per MSR before 31st December 2017.
- (ii) All the relevant provisions of the Minimum Standards Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 and 10 of the “Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;

- (iii) All the relevant requirements under the (Minimum Standard of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda); and
- (iv) All the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.
4. The college administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teachers and non-teaching staff in the college and requisite staff in the hospital, as per the relevant CCIM Regulations, are in position before the admission of the first batch of students in the 1st professional of BAMS course is made, under intimation to the Central Government and CCIM.
5. The college has to develop the requisite infrastructure for IInd, IIIrd and IVth professionals well in time as per the CCIM norms which will be verified and reported by the CCIM at least three months before the start of next professional and accordingly, the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be issued.
6. The college administration may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under section 14(2) of the IMCC Act, 1970 at that time when the first batch of students admitted against above UG course appears for the first final professional examination of the said course.
